REGULAR APPOINTMENTS

1. Post Graduate Teacher (PGTs)

1.1. Eligibility condition for PGT (Psychology).

1.1.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

1.1.2. Master's Degree in relevant subject completed as regular course with at least 55% marks from a recognised university/institution.

1.1.3. Bachelor of Education Degree in relevant subject or equivalent completed as a regular course from a University/ Institution recognised by Govt of India/UGC/AICTE/ National Council of Teacher Education with at least 50% marks.

1.1.4. Should have studied requisite subject at both Senior Secondary and Graduation levels.

1.1.5. Preference will be given to candidates having experience of teaching relevant subject in recognised CBSE School(s).

FIXED TERM CONTRACT

2. Trained Graduate Teacher (TGTs)

2.1. Eligibility condition for TGT (Hindi, English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Sanskrit)

2.1.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

2.1.2. Bachelors Degree in relevant subject studied as a regular course and qualified with at least 55% marks with relevant subject from a recognised university /institution.

2.1.3. Bachelor of Education Degree in relevant subject or equivalent completed as a regular course from a University/ Institution recognised by Govt of India/UGC/AICTE/ National Council of Teacher Education with at least 50% marks.

2.1.4. Should have studied the relevant subject at Sr Secondary also.

2.1.5. Preference will be given to the candidates having regular Masters' Degree in relevant subject from a recognised university and/or experience of teaching in relevant subject in recognised CBSE school(s).

3. Primary Teacher (PRTs)

3.1. Eligibility condition for PRT (General, Computer Science, Physical Training Instructor, Yoga, Art& Craft)

3.1.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

3.1.2. Bachelors Degree completed as a regular course from any recognised University/ Institution, with minimum 55% marks aggregate AND Bachelor of Education/ Diploma in Elementary Education or equivalent completed as a regular course from a University/ Institution recognised by Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE/ National Council of Teacher Education with at least 50% marks.

Or

Senior Secondary (Class XII or its equivalent) from a recognised board with minimum 55% marks aggregate AND two-year Diploma in Elementary Education/ for-year Bachelor of Elementary Education completed as a regular course from a recognised University/ Institution with at least 50%.

3.1.3. Preference will be given to candidates having experience of teaching in reputed Foundational and Preparatory stage CBSE school(s).

3.2. Eligibility condition for PRT (Speech Therapist).

3.2.1. Candidates must have completed a Bachelor's Degree in Speech and Hearing Sciences or a related field from a recognized university.

3.2.2. Ability to correspond independently in English.

3.2.3. Age to be between 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

3.3. Eligibility condition for PRT (Occupational Therapist))

3.3.1. B.Sc(OT)/B.OT with minimum two (02) years experience in school set up or in pediatric /neurological/ psychiatric set up/ M.Sc(OT) /M.OT

3.3.2. Ability to correspond independently in English.

3.3.3. Age to be between 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

3.4. Eligibility condition for Asst Librarian.

3.4.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

3.4.2. 10+2 with one year Diploma in Library Science completed as a regular course from any University/ Institution recognised by the Govt of

India/UGC/AICTE, with minimum 55% marks aggregate in the relevant subject.

4. *Balvatika Teacher (KG)*

4.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

4.2. Senior Secondary Class (Class XII or its equivalent) from a recognized board with minimum 55% marks aggregate.

4.3. 2 year Diploma in Nursery Teacher Education/ Pre-school Education/Early Childhood Education programme or equivalent Or BEd (Nursery) completed as a regular course with at least 50% marks from a recognised university/institution.

4.4. Preference will be given to candidates having experience of teaching in reputed Foundational stage school(s).

5. *Special Educator (KG)*

5.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

5.2. Graduate with BEd (Special Education) or BEd with two year Diploma in Special Education or Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education with at least 50% marks from a recognised university/institution.

Or

Any other equivalent qualification approved by Rehabilitation Council of India as a regular course and qualified with at least 50% marks from recognised university/institution.

5.3. Valid registration with Rehabilitation Council of India would be desirable.

5.4. Preference will be given to candidates having experience of teaching in reputed CBSE school(s).

6. *Lab Assistant (Biology & Chemistry)*

6.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

6.2. 10+2 in Science/ Diploma in relevant skill domain (AI, Robotics, Computer Applications etc)/ Lab Technician Course completed as a regular course from any Institution recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE, with minimum 55% marks aggregate in the relevant subject.

6.3. Graduation in relevant subject with at least 50% marks and experience in recognised CBSE schools would be desirable.

7. *Other Common Requirements for all Posts mentioned at Ser 1 & 6.*

7.1. Should have good personality with excellent communication skills in English and ability to communicate in Hindi.

7.2. Should have working knowledge of computer/ AI tools/ ERP software/ Learning Management System (LMS) packages and should be proficient in using Microsoft Office software.

7.3. Should be physically and medically fit and should possess a high moral character.

7.4. **Age Relaxation for ex- Naval School Staff.** The upper age limit for ex-Naval School staff will be relaxed by the number of years of his/ her carried forward experience in previous Naval Schools, subject to the individual's age not exceeding 55 years.

7.5. **BEd through Distance Education.** Candidates who have acquired BEd in Distance Education mode before the year 2014 and possessing five (05) or more years of teaching experience in CBSE recognised schools will be considered, provided he/she fulfil other eligibility conditions.

8. **Eligibility conditions for Data Entry Operator (DEO)**

8.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

8.2. **Academics/ Experience.**

8.2.1. Bachelor of Commerce (or equivalent qualification in Armed Forces) with adequate knowledge of clerical duties.

8.2.2. Typing speed of 40 words per minute. Ability to correspond independently in English.

8.2.3. Three years' experience in handling of office work. Preference will be given to the candidates having relevant experience in the rank of PO or above, or equivalent in the Army/ IAF.

8.2.4. Computer proficiency in MS Office/ Office Automation/ AI tool ERP Software.

9. **Eligibility conditions for Store Assistant.**

9.1. **Age limit.** 21 to 50 years as on 01 Jul 25.

9.2. **Academics/ Experience.**

9.2.1. 10+2/Diploma (or equivalent qualification in Armed Forces).

9.2.2. At least three years of store keeping experience with adequate knowledge of maintenance of inventory and accounting of stores in a reputed organisation.

9.2.3. Good working proficiency in Microsoft Office tools Excel, Word and Power Point.

9.2.4. Ability to correspond independently in English.

9.2.5. Preference will be given to the candidates having at least five years relevant experience in the rank of PO or above, or equivalent in the Army/ IAF.

10. **Place of Joining.** The candidates selected for any advertised post may be appointed for Navy Children School at Nausena Baugh, Navy Children School at SVN Colony and Naval Kindergarten at Dolphin Hills.

11. **Other Common Requirements for all Posts mentioned at Ser 8 & 9.**

10.1. Should have good personality with excellent communication skills in English and ability to communicate in Hindi.

10.2. The upper age limit for ex-Naval School staff will be relaxed by the number of years of his/ her carried forward experience of working in previous Naval Schools, subject to the individual's age not exceeding 55 years.

10.3. Should be physically and medically fit.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Candidates are required to apply through "**Online**" mode only for the post(s) as per the advertisement/vacancy notified. The Application form in any other mode will not be accepted.
2. A candidate may apply for more than one post, if he/she is eligible, need to fill application form separately. Only the Shortlisted applicants must submit the examination fee of Rs 100/- (for each post) on the day of written examination.
3. The candidates should fill only one application form for one post. Multiple applications formats submitted by a candidate for same post, if detected at any stage, will be cancelled.
4. The examination date, once allotted shall not be changed under any circumstances. The request in this regard, for whatsoever reason, shall not be entertained.
5. Candidates must carefully read the instructions contained in the online application on the website for filling up the application form. Candidates not complying with the instructions will liable to be summarily disqualified.
6. The online applications should be filled carefully as per instructions contained in the online application format and submit the same Online. Login Id and password would be generated on successful submission of application for registration and will be sent on the registered e-mail address of the candidate.
