Assistant Librarian	➤ 10 + 2 with one year Diploma in Library Science completed as a regular course from any University / Institution recognized by the Govt of India / UGC/AICTE, with a minimum 55% marks aggregate in the relevant subject.
Sports Coach /Yoga	➤ Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education (B.P. Ed) OR Bachelor's Degree in any subject with a Diploma in Yoga from a recognized university or institute.
Kannada Teacher	➤ Graduation with a minimum of 50% marks along with a degree of Bachelor of Education (B. Ed.) from any recognized university/ Institution recognized by Govt of India.
