(i) Should possess good personality with excellent communication skills in English and ability to communicate in Hindi.

(ii) Should possess working knowledge of computers/AI tools/ERP software/LMS packages and should be proficient in using Microsoft Office Software.

(iii) Should be physically and medically fit and should possess a high moral character.

(c) **B.Ed through Distance Education.** Candidates who have acquired B.Ed in distance Education mode before the year 2014 and are in possession of 05 (Five) or

more years of teaching experience in CBSE recognised schools shall also be considered for recruitment to various teaching posts, provided they fulfill other eligibility conditions.
