3.4 **B.Ed through Distance Education.** Candidates who have acquired B.Ed in distance Education mode **before the year 2014** and possessing **05 (Five)** or more years of teaching experience in CBSE recognised schools shall also be

considered for recruitment to various teaching posts provided they fulfil other eligibility conditions.
