SYLLABUS FOR COMMON WRITTEN TEST (CWT)

(A) The format of the Common Written Test (CWT) will be as under:

(i) Section A: Objective-type questions for testing English, child Psychology, Teaching Methodologies, Logical Reasoning, General Awareness, Numerical Ability, and Personality.

(ii) Section B: Objective-type question of the concerned subject of teaching.

(iii) Section C: Essay-type questions on education-related general topics to assess the Writing Skills, Logical Thinking, and Psychology of candidates.

(B) It will be mandatory for all candidates to score at least 50% marks to qualify for the written test, to be considered for an interview: -
