#### **Announcement: School Prefectural Council Selection 2026–27**

We are pleased to announce that the selection process for the School Prefectural Council for the academic year 2026–27 is now open.

The Prefectural Council plays a vital role in nurturing leadership, responsibility, and teamwork among students. We encourage all eligible and interested students to come forward and actively participate in the selection process.

#### **Eligibility & Guidelines:**

- Open to all students in classes IX to XII (Secondary) and Classes IV and V (Primary).
- Candidates must exhibit exemplary behaviour and leadership qualities.

The composition of Prefectural Council (Student Council) at Navy Schools shall be as mentioned below:-

**\*Discipline Committee Members** - 12 members (3 each from classes IX, X, XI and XII) shall be selected from the candidates who have filed nominations for other posts but do not make it to the Final list. Criteria will be meritorious performance in the interview.

**Candidates who are not interested in being a member of the Discipline Committee should inform the same to the Prefectural Selection Committee while submitting the nomination form.**

## Selection Procedure

Candidates shall undergo the selection process comprising following phases of evaluation:

- (a) Phase I - Academics, CCA, Sports and NCC/SCC/Scouts
- (b) Phase II - Written Test and Interview
- (c) Phase III - Speech and Election

### Phase I

**General Guidelines** – General guidelines for applying for any post are as follows:

- 1) A student can apply **for a maximum of two posts** only.
- 2) A student who is willing to be part of the student council is to file a Nomination form as per the proforma placed at **Appendix A (Nomination Form)**.  
Following shall be the integral part of the nomination form
  - a) Parental consent
  - b) A disclaimer stating that 'Decision of the Selection Committee shall be final and binding'.
  - c) **A penalty of 5 negative marks** shall be imposed for students who were **issued with a warning letter** during the two years preceding the date for filing the nomination.
  - d) A student who has been **suspended on disciplinary grounds** during the two years preceding the date for filing the nomination **will not be eligible** for candidature.
  - e) Marks scored by the students in **Annual Examination of the previous class only** shall be considered for all posts.

**Eligibility Criteria** - Minimum eligibility criteria for Secondary students to apply for Student Council post is tabulated below:-

| Ser No | Post                              | Marks obtained in Annual Exam of the Previous Class |   |

|        |                                   | Secondary   | Primary   |
| 1.     | Head Boy and Head Girl            | 75 % and above                                      | Four A* - scored for concepts in the Assessment IV (for English, Hindi, Mathematics, EVS) in previous class |
| 2.     | Deputy Head Boy and Deputy Girl   | 75 % and above                                      |   |
| 3.     | Sports Captain( Boy and Girl)     | 60 % and above                                      |   |
| 4.     | House Captains/Vice Captains      | 70 % and above                                      |   |
| 5.     | Cultural Captain / Vice - Captain | 70 % and above                                      |   |
| 6.     | Prefects                          | 70 % and above                                      |   |

\*Candidates shortlisted after Phase I shall take part in Phase II

### **Phase II**

- 1) Written Test – based on general awareness, school related information, expected qualities and duties of a member of Student Council.
- 2) Interview- based on Attitude and Interpersonal skill, Confidence, Leadership qualities, Personality and Responsibility.

\*Shortlisted candidates shall participate in Phase III

### **Phase III**

- 1) Speech Campaign where the candidate will be assessed based on Relevance of the Content, Communication, Presentation, Interaction and Mannerisms.
- 2) Election – Teachers and students of respective classes from which the candidature is permitted, will cast their votes.

**We encourage all eligible students to participate in this process. Being a part of the School Prefectural Council is a prestigious role that offers a unique opportunity to develop leadership skills, make a positive impact, and represent your fellow students.**
